1 Corinthians 15:1-34

* What Happened to Jesus When He Died? 1-11

- He was [buried](#). This was proof He [died](#).
- He was [raised](#) on the [third day](#). Eyewitnesses include:
 - Peter
 - The 12 (11 without Judas)
 - 500 at once
 - James
 - The 12 again
 - Paul

* How the Resurrection of Jesus Impacts Believers in Jesus 12-28

- If Christ [DID NOT](#) rise. (12-19)
 - Our [preaching](#) is empty
 - Your faith is [empty](#)
 - We are [liars](#)
 - There is no [forgiveness](#)
 - There is no [eternal life](#)
 - Believers have wasted [their life](#)
- If Christ [DID](#) rise. (20-28)
 - The resurrection of the believer is [as certain](#) as [death](#).
 - He will abolish all other [rule](#), [power](#) and [authority](#) (including [death!](#)).
 - Jesus will [fully](#) and [ultimately](#) glorify the [Father](#).

* Your Actions Prove What You Believe About the Resurrection 29-34

- Resurrection conviction determines my ["Yes"](#).
 - I say "Yes" to [hardship](#) for the sake of the [Kingdom](#).
 - I say "Yes" to [death](#) for the sake of the [Kingdom](#).
- Resurrection conviction determines my ["No"](#).
 - I say "No" to living for [this life only](#).
 - I say "No" to joining in on the [foolish thinking](#) and [living](#) of those around me.
 - I say "No" to the [desires of my flesh](#).
 - The crucial question? *Do the priorities of my life reveal I believe in the resurrection?*
