1 Corinthians 15:35-58

* The resurrection of the believer is as [certain as death](#).

* What Will Our New Bodies Be Like? vs.35-49

- The image of a [seed](#). (vs.35-38)
 - The seed is [not](#) the body.
 - Our [physical](#) body is the [seed](#) for our [spiritual](#) body.

- The Variation of Bodies (vs.39-49)
 - Earthly vs. [heavenly](#) (vs.39-41)
 - Natural vs. [spiritual](#) (vs.42-44)
 - » [perishable](#) → [imperishable](#)
 - » [dishonor](#) → [glorious](#)
 - » [weakness](#) → [power](#)
 - The two [prototypes](#) (vs.45-49)
 - » [Adam](#) is the prototype for our [natural](#) body
 - » The [resurrected Jesus](#) is our prototype for the [spiritual](#) body

* When Will We Receive Our New Bodies? vs.50-57

- Not until Christ [returns](#) at the [rapture](#)
- Those who died (in Christ) will be [first](#), then those who are alive
- The change will be [instantaneous](#)
- Death will have lost its final hold on believers. 3 stages.
 - » [Salvation](#) » [Sanctification](#) » [Glorification](#)

* How Should We Live? v.58 Resurrection resolves...

- Be [steadfast](#) and [immovable](#)
 - » Timeless distractions: Luke. 8:14: [worries](#), [riches](#), [pleasures](#)
- Always [abounding](#) in the [work](#) of the [Lord](#)
 - » Making [disciples](#)
 - » [Winning](#) the lost, [building](#) believers, equipping [members](#), multiplying [leaders](#)
