• Marriage As God Intended Marriage

- Marriage is [good](#) ...so is [singleness](#). v 1-2, 7-9
- Marriage is to be [monogamous](#) and [heterosexual](#). v 2
- Sex and love are to be [synonymous](#) in marriage. v 3-6
 - This is often not true because love equals [serving others](#) and sex is often [self-serving](#).*
 - God [owns](#) my body. My spouse has been [given authority](#) over it from [God](#).*
 - If [I](#) own my body, [selfishness](#) will prevail.*
 - If [my spouse](#) owns my body, [demandingness](#) will prevail.*
 - If [God](#) owns your body and has given your spouse [authority over it](#), then [oneness](#) will prevail.*
 - Abstinence in marriage should be [mutual](#), [temporary](#) and for [prayer](#).*
