

“Marriage Wisdom for the Unmarried” 1 Corinthians 7:25-40

- His wisdom is from the Lord, but not quoting the Lord. v. 25

- Singles considering marriage should...

- Be sure the appropriate time is evaluated. v 26-31

(Four references to time. v 26, 28, 29, 31)

Is there time for the necessary attention needed for a change to married life?

Will you be able to live as the married couple you are becoming?

- Be sure the new “concern” if fully understood. v 32-35

Concern (ed) = 5 times.

Devotion to Christ becomes divided with a spouse.

This is an appropriate divided devotion, but divided nonetheless.

- Be sure the wisdom of the father and others is sought. v 36-39

The father no longer makes the choice, but his wisdom remains relevant.

Recognize others can see what you cannot.

You are free to choose, but your choice is for life.

- Be sure to think carefully about remarriage. v 39-40

Remarriage is permissible with the death of a spouse.

Marriage and remarriage must only be to another believer.

Remarriage may not be advisable.
