

“Conscience and Community” Part 2

1 Corinthians 10:23-31, Romans 14:1-23

Review: A community of believers can live in unity in oneness of conscience when: *Romans 14:19-21*

1. Each person is committed to allowing the [Word of God](#) to [shape](#) their [conscience](#).
 2. Each person is [lovingly](#) willing to [use](#) and [lose](#) their [liberty](#) for the sake of [others](#).
- The loving exercise of conscience requires...
 - Each person to be [convinced](#) in their [own](#) mind. *Romans 14:5, 22-23*
 - Personal convictions to be held [without condemnation](#) of the [weaker](#) brother or the [stronger](#) brother. *Romans 14:1-4, 10-13b*
 - [Discernment](#) to be applied to each [unique](#) situation.
[Inconsistency](#) is actually [consistent](#) in loving community. *1 Corinthians 10:23-28*
 - Consideration of both the [believers](#) and the [unbelievers](#) involved. *1 Corinthians 10:32-33*
 - A core commitment to do [ALL](#) to the [GLORY of God](#). *1 Corinthians 10:31*
